



# PRESTATYN HIGH STREET PUBLIC REALM IMPROVEMENTS CONSULTATION

As part of the UK Government's Pride of Place and Natural Environment project, Denbighshire County Council has been awarded funding to carry out a number of projects that will help to improve the look and feel of some key areas of Denbighshire.

One of these areas is the public realm (visible space) in Prestatyn High Street.

We are looking at making improvements to how Prestatyn High Street looks and feels.

We hope the project will:

- 1. Make public areas look and feel nicer
- 2. Make it easier to access the town centre from key locations such as the retail park, railway station and bus station
- 3. Improve signage around the town so people can find their way around more easily
- 4. Encourage greater tourism and investment in the town, and encourage people to support independent retailers

Before we start this project, we'd like to know:

- 1. How you access the town centre
- 2. What services are important to you
- 3. If there is anything we could do that might encourage you to change how often you come, or how much time you spend in Prestatyn town centre
