THE NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE SYSTEM

Base map constructed on Transverse Mercator Projection, Airy Spheroid, OSGB (1936) Datum. Vertical datum mean sea level (Newlyn)

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 1km intervals. To give a unique reference defining the position of a point to within 100 metres proceed as follows:-
