



Deemed Dedication of Rights of Way

**Statutory Declaration
Section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980**

I [REDACTED] DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:-

1. I am and have been since 11 March 1968 the owner of the land known as Coed Accas more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.

2. On the 22 April 2015 I deposited with Denbighshire Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating my property by red edging which stated that (the ways coloured blue on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths) (no other ways had been dedicated as highways over my property).

3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 22 April 2015 referred to in 2. above (other than those highways with vehicular status, bridleways, footpaths marked in the appropriate colour on the plan accompanying this declaration) and at the present time I have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over my property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 22 April 2015 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1935.
